MINUTES WEST PASCO MODEL PILOTS ASSOCIATION CLUB MEETING December 18, 2019


The General Meeting of the West Pasco Model Pilots Association was held December 18, 2019 at the Fred K. Marchman Technical College. The meeting was called to order at 7:03pm by President John Flood. The minutes from the November meeting were accepted unanimously as read without any additions or corrections. Dave Miller submitted a financial report detailing expenditures since our last meeting. The Club now has \$4513.260 in our checking account and our savings account balance is \$5214.86. After Dave explained that the payment for solid waste disposal was for two months instead of one month, the treasurer's report was accepted unanimously by those members present. Dave then said that, up until the day of the Club meeting (12/18), only 39 members had renewed their membership for 2020. He said we need approximately 40 additional renewals to cover our expected expenditures for 2020.

President Flood reminded the group that, due to the recent vandalism, we are now locking the gate on our access road.

Gary Stires said that our pit and common area at the field need a good cleaning. Everyone agreed but no definite plans were made for accomplishing the cleanup. Gary also commented on the use of inappropriate language by some members at our field. Although this is unacceptable to most of us, there appears to be no way to control the language of our members since this subject is not currently addressed in our Constitution, By-Laws, or Field Use Rules documents.

As there was no other business, a motion to adjourn was made, seconded, and passed at 7:30pm.
